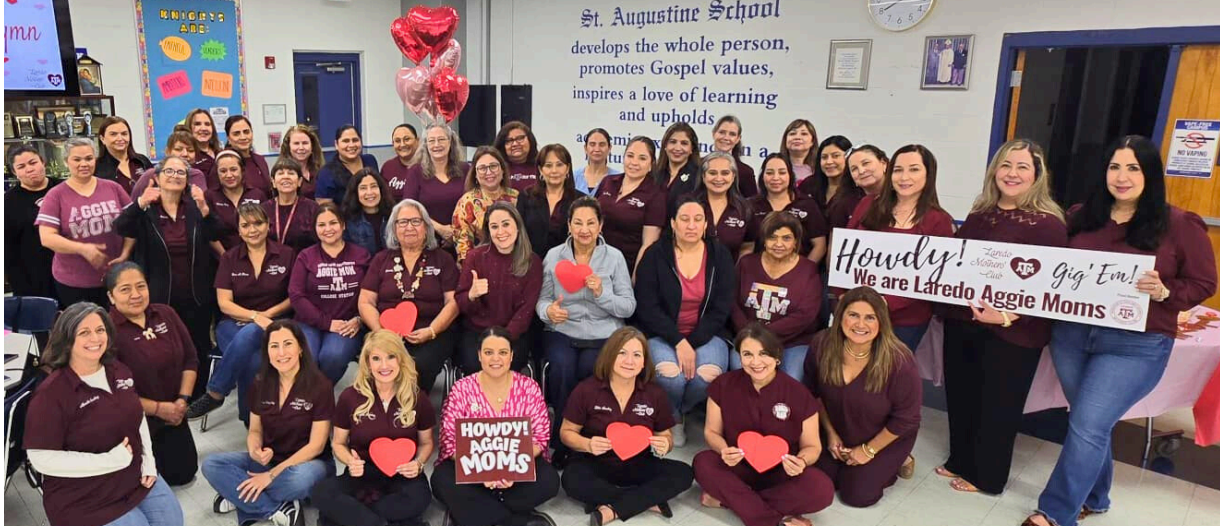

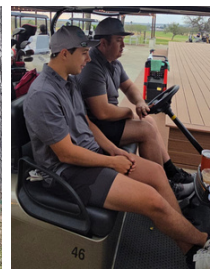


Club Highlights *//////* All about golf...

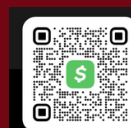
